Awards for Internationals and Students from Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands

U.S. citizens and Permanent Resident Aliens who are residents of Puerto Rico or the U.S. Virgin Islands, and internationals entering on an F-1 visa, may be eligible for one of these two programs:

Latin American/Caribbean Scholarship Program

Assigns in-state tuition prices PLUS \$1,000 per year to help cover tuition and fees

Out-of-State Resident Presidential Scholarship Program

\$15,000 per year (\$60,000 over four years)

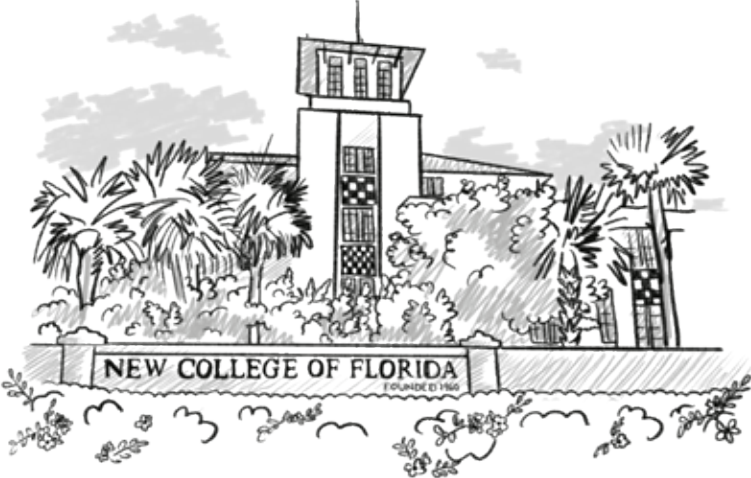
IT'S TIME TO THRIVE. FIND YOURSELF HERE.

Here's what we need:

1. Your New College Application or Common Application (commonapp.org). We'll waive the fee. Recommendations are optional.
2. SAT or ACT scores (self-reported scores are fine for reviewing your application)
3. TOEFL or IELTS Scores (if English is not your native language) *
4. Transcripts from each school attended, from high school through college or university
5. Certified Transcript Translation (if your transcripts are not provided in English)
6. Credential Evaluation: We require a NACES-member course-by-course credential evaluation with GPA for academic records from most schools that do not use the U.S. system, with the exception of International Baccalaureate programs. You can order your certified translation with your credential evaluation.

**If English is your native language, the language of instruction for your education, and/or you have already taken the SAT or ACT, please contact us at (941)-487-5000 or admissions@ncf.edu for a possible waiver of TOEFL/IELTS test scores.*
